MEMBERSHIP FEES

SIGNING ON FEE 24/25 SEASON IS FREE FOR U7'S - U16'S INCLUSIVE OF BOTH AGE GROUPS.

THE DEANS' SUBS ARE CHARGED AT THE RATES BELOW. SUBS ARE TAKEN VIA DIRECT DEBIT (DD) IF NOT PAID FOR THE YEAR IN ONE GO.

THE SUBS CAN BE PAID VIA **1, 3 OR 9 INSTALMENT'S - THE INDIVIDUALS CHOICE, SUBS ARE PAYABLE BETWEEN 01/08/24 - 30/04/25.** FIRST PAYMENT (BY WHATEVER PLAN CHOSEN) MUST BE MADE BETWEEN 01/08/24 AND 31/08/24.

- 1. IF YOU CHOOSE ONE PAYMENT, ONE CHARGE, PAID WHEN YOU SIGN ON - NO DD.**
- 2. IF YOU CHOOSE THREE PAYMENTS, ONE INITIAL PAYMENT WHEN YOU SIGN ON AND TWO DD CHARGES, THE ADDITIONAL CHARGES WILL BE ON THE SAME DAY OR NEXT WORKING DAY TO THE ORIGINAL CHARGE IN NOVEMBER 24 AND FEBRUARY 25.**
- 3. IF YOU CHOOSE NINE PAYMENTS, ONE INITIAL PAYMENT WHEN YOU SIGN ON FOLLOWED BY 8 DD CHARGES ON SAME DAY OR NEXT WORKING DAY IN PRECEDING MONTHS.**

THE CHARGES BELOW EXPLAIN WHAT THE COST IS FOR PARENTS/CARERS

ONE CHILD, £25 PER MONTH FOR 9 MONTHS OR £75 PER 3 MONTHS OR A ONE OFF PAYMENT OF £225.

ONE CHILD = £225 FOR THE SEASON.

TWO CHILDREN, £40 PER MONTH FOR 9 MONTHS, £120 PER 3 MONTHS OR A ONE OFF PAYMENT OF £360.

TWO CHILDREN = £360 FOR THE SEASON.

THREE CHILDREN, £50 PER MONTH FOR 9 MONTHS, £150 PER 3 MONTHS OR A ONE OFF PAYMENT OF £450.

THREE CHILDREN = £450 FOR THE SEASON.

FOUR CHILDREN, £55 PER MONTH FOR 9 MONTHS, £165 PER 3 MONTHS OR A ONE OFF PAYMENT OF £495.

FOUR CHILDREN = £495 FOR THE SEASON.

HAVE 5 OR MORE CHILDREN? WHEN THEY ARE ALL REGISTERED AND PLAYING FOR DEANS TEAMS YOU STILL PAY £495 PER YEAR. CONTACT DAVE THE SECRETARY IF THIS IS THE CASE.

COMPLAINTS PROCESS

PROCESS TO MAKE A COMPLAINT

FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF ANY DOUBT, ANY COMPLAINTS SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO YOUR TEAM MANAGER IN THE FIRST INSTANCE, IF THE ISSUE CAN'T BE RESOLVED, CONTACT THE CHAIR.

IF THE TEAM MANAGER HAS A COMPLAINT, THEY SHOULD SPEAK WITH THE INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED AND IF OUTCOME NOT ACCEPTABLE, REFER TO THE CHAIR.

THIS PROCESS IS FOR DEANS ONLY! EXPECT A PERIOD OF UP TO TWO WEEKS FOR A RESPONSE.

IF YOU HAVE NOT FOLLOWED STEPS ABOVE, YOU WILL BE REFERRED BACK WHEN CONTACT MADE.

WHEN HELD, ALL COMPLAINT MEETINGS WILL BE MINUTED.

COMPLAINTS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED IN WRITING, DETAILED WITH ANY/ALL ISSUES, IF INVITED TO A MEETING, ONLY THESE ISSUES WILL BE DISCUSSED. PHONE CALLS AND TEXT MESSAGES WON'T BE ACTIONED. THE EMAIL ADDRESS FOR COMPLAINTS IS chairman@dylfc.co.uk

ISSUES

IF YOU HAVE ANY ISSUES DURING A GAME, MAKE THE CHAIR AWARE, DOESN'T MATTER IF GAME IS HOME OR AWAY.

THE COMMITTEE ARE HERE TO SUPPORT YOU IF REQUIRED AND STEVE AND DAVE ARE AVAILABLE AS COACH MENTORS TO DISCUSS ANYTHING.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

YOUTH TEAM MANAGER/COACH/ASSISTANT COACH/SECRETARY

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE YOUTH TEAM MANAGER/COACH?

A GRASSROOTS MANAGER/COACH SHOULD LOOK TO CREATE A FUN, SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT FOR YOUNG PEOPLE TO LEARN AND PROSPER WITHIN A SPORTING ENVIRONMENT. CHILDREN PARTICIPATING IN GRASSROOTS FOOTBALL WILL HAVE DIFFERENT MOTIVATIONS – BUT WHAT IS IMPORTANT IS THAT THEY ENJOY PLAYING FOOTBALL, AS A MANAGER/COACH, EVERY EXPERIENCE YOU PROVIDE SHOULD BE BASED AROUND THE PLAYERS BEING GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO PLAY.

ANOTHER ROLE OF THE GRASSROOTS MANAGER/COACH IS BUILDING AND DEVELOPING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PLAYER, PARENT, MANAGER/COACH, AND CLUB. THE RELATIONSHIPS BUILT WITH THESE INDIVIDUALS WILL HELP THEM TO ACHIEVE TOGETHER.

GRASSROOTS MANAGERS/COACHES WILL OFTEN HAVE TO WORK WITH CHILDREN OF DIFFERENT ABILITIES, GENDER, AND NEEDS. THEREFORE, IT'S VITALLY IMPORTANT THAT GRASSROOTS DON'T OVERLOOK THE IMPORTANCE OF PARTICIPATION AND PROVIDING EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL. WE ALL KNOW THAT CHILDREN LEARN AND DEVELOP AT DIFFERENT RATES, THEREFORE, YOU SHOULD EMBRACE THE OPPORTUNITY THAT COMES WITH THIS AND BE THERE READY TO SUPPORT THOSE CHILDREN THROUGH THOSE HIGHS AND LOWS OF PLAYING FOOTBALL.

MANAGERS/COACHES ALSO HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO REPRESENT THEIR CLUB AND COMMUNITY IN THE RIGHT WAY. EVERYBODY SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEY FULLY UNDERSTAND THE VALUES OF THE CLUB AND WHAT THEY'RE REPRESENTING. MANAGERS/COACHES' WILL NEED TO DEMONSTRATE THE BEHAVIOURS BOTH ON AND OFF THAT ARE ALIGNED TO THE CLUBS' VALUES.

CODE OF CONDUCT 24/25 SEASON

ALL PLAYERS AND VOLUNTEERS MUST SIGN UP – IF A VERY YOUNG CHILD PARENT/CARER SIGNATURE BESIDE CHILDS NAME.

RESPONSIBILITIES

YOUTH TEAM MANAGER/COACH/ASSISTANT COACH/SECRETARY

MATCH DAY SAFETY AND ETIQUETTE

ON HOME MATCH DAYS, THE TEAM MANAGER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SETTING UP OF THE PITCH AND THE RETURN OF EQUIPMENT TO THE "CAGE" AND THE "SHED" IF NO GAMES ON AFTER THEM.

THE MANAGER & COACH(ES) SHOULD GET PARENTS INVOLVED TO ASSIST WITH THE SETTING UP AND SETTING DOWN:-

1. ALL 5v5, 7v7 & 9v9 GOALS ARE TO BE BROUGHT OUT OF COMPOUND (AND RETURNED IF NO GAME AFTER YOU) WHEN REQUIRED. THE 11 A SIDE NETS DON'T REQUIRE FIXING – THEY DO HOWEVER NEED TO BE LOCKED BY THE LAST TEAM USING THEM. ALL THREE TOGETHER, ALWAYS CHECK THE MATCH PLAN AND CONFIRM IN THE GROUP IF GOALS STAYING OUT OR BEING PUT BACK.
 2. WHEN THE GOALS ARE PLACED, THEY MUST BE FIXED TO THE GROUND WITH THE HOOKS TAKEN FROM THE SHED. IF NO GAME AFTER YOU ALL HOOKS TO BE REMOVED, PLACE BACK IN THE BAG AND RETURN TO THE SHED (IF THEY ARE MISSING REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE, GAMES CAN'T GO AHEAD UNTIL PROVIDED).
 3. RESPECT BARRIERS NEED TO BE ERECTED FOR ALL GAMES, REGARDLESS IF FRIENDLY OR NOT AND MUST RUN THE LENGTH OF THE FULL PITCH FOR THE 5v5 AND 7v7s AND BARRIER LENGTH (60M) FOR ALL OTHER PITCHES. WHEN THEY ARE FINISHED WITH, PUT BACK IN THE BAG AND COVER SPIKES WITH THE RUBBERS PROVIDED. BAGS AND REELS AREN'T TO BE PUT IN THE SHED SEPARATELY! ONE BAG!
 4. CORNER FLAGS – 6FT CORNER FLAGS FOR ALL PITCHES EXCEPT THE 5v5 WHERE WE HAVE 5FT FLAGS AT PRESENT. USE AND RETURN IF NO GAME AFTER YOU.
 5. BUCKETS (ORANGE AND YELLOW) MUST BE BROUGHT OUT AND POSITIONED AT THE START OF THE SPECTATOR LINES. IF A GAME AFTER YOU, LEAVE INSITU, IF NOT BRING IN COLLECTING ALL THE RUBBISH LEFT BY THE TEAMS AND PLACE BY THE BINS AT FRONT OF CLUB IF YOU CAN'T EMPTY YOURSELF.

1. 5FT FLAGS TO THE LEFT, ALL OTHER FLAGS TO THE RIGHT.
2. ALL BARRIERS NEATLY TO THE RIGHT.
3. ALL PEGS TO FRONT LEFT OF SHED AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE.

BAD

1. ALL FLAGS LUMPED TOGETHER.
2. BARRIERS LEFT AND RIGHT (NOT IDEAL) BUT MAIN ISSUE, REEL HAS BEEN THROWN IN SHED WITH LEGS WITHOUT WINDING OR PUTTING IN BAG. UNACCEPTABLE.
3. HARD TO GET AT THE PEGS.

MANAGERS NEED TO CHECK THE SHED AND MAKE RIGHT WHEN THEY ARE RETURNING KIT. DELEGATE BY ALL MEANS BUT SOMEONE FROM EACH TEAM NEEDS TO TAKE OWNERSHIP AND SORT,.

2. LOCKS NOT USED, OR IF LOST NOT REPORTED.

MANAGERS NEED TO CHECK AND MAKE RIGHT WHEN GAMES OVER.
DELEGATE BY ALL MEANS BUT SOMEONE FROM EACH TEAM NEEDS TO
TAKE OWNERSHIP AND SORT.
